

## FORTY-SECOND ORDINARY SESSION

### ***In re* PEETERS (No. 1)**

#### **Judgment No. 384**

THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint brought against the International Patent Institute by Mr. Stefaan Bernard Peeters on 11 July 1977, the Institute's reply of 1 August and the complainant's letter of 23 August 1977 inviting the Tribunal to stay judgment until it had heard his second complaint;

A. Considering that the complainant asked the Tribunal to quash the Director-General's decision of 18 April 1977 on promotions from grade A6 to grade A5 and to order that a new list of candidates should be drawn up, with due regard to the change in the complainant's performance mark for 1975 and with a view to a new decision on promotions from A6 to A5;

B. Considering that by a letter of 6 December 1978 the complainant informed the Registrar of the Tribunal that he wished to withdraw suit on the grounds that the pursuance of his first complaint depended on the success of his second one, which the Tribunal had dismissed by Judgment No. 352 dated 13 November 1978;

C. Considering that by a communication dated 18 December 1978 the defendant organisation stated that it had no objection to the withdrawal of suit;

D. Considering that suit is unreservedly withdrawn;

DECISION:

The withdrawal of suit is hereby recorded.
